PROCEDURE FOR STUDENT PICK-UP AT CHARTER BUS STOPS

The guidelines for students allowed to depart a terminal/destination stop while utilizing the MHS Charter Bus Service is listed as follows:

- Senior Division students 16 years of age or older will be the **only** students allowed to depart the terminal/destination without being met by an Approved Adult provided a signed waiver on file with Home Life.
- Any students without a waiver must be met by an Approved Adult. This *includes any siblings* of Senior Division students who have a signed waiver.
- **If after 15 minutes** an Approved Adult has not met their student, AND arrangements cannot be made between the Bus Driver (due to other stops or time constraints), the Adult Bus Monitor and the Approved Adult, the student will be returned to MHS on the charter bus with the Adult Bus Monitor.

Any students not met by their Approved Adult at their respective destination who are returned to the MHS campus will lose their future privilege to utilize the MHS Charter Bus Program for the remainder of the school year.
