Through this CTE program area, students are exposed to the many career opportunities with family-sustaining wages available in these industries. They learn about employer expectations as well as the challenges they may face through real-life learning experiences. These environments include classroom and professional office simulation spaces where students can take their understanding and academic growth to the next level—increasing their knowledge each school year.

Students explore careers in education, social work, counseling, and other related occupations. As they go through high school, they narrow their focus and discover the professional expectations and degree requirements for that career. Students also regularly hear from guest speakers who are experts in these fields and take part in observational and collaborative learning experiences with elementary students.

By senior year, students participate in work-based learning and internships aligned with their specific interests. Throughout the program area, they build core skills, pursue industry-recognized certifications, such as a Child Development Associate (CDA), and develop the empathy, communication, and leadership qualities essential for success in these careers.
