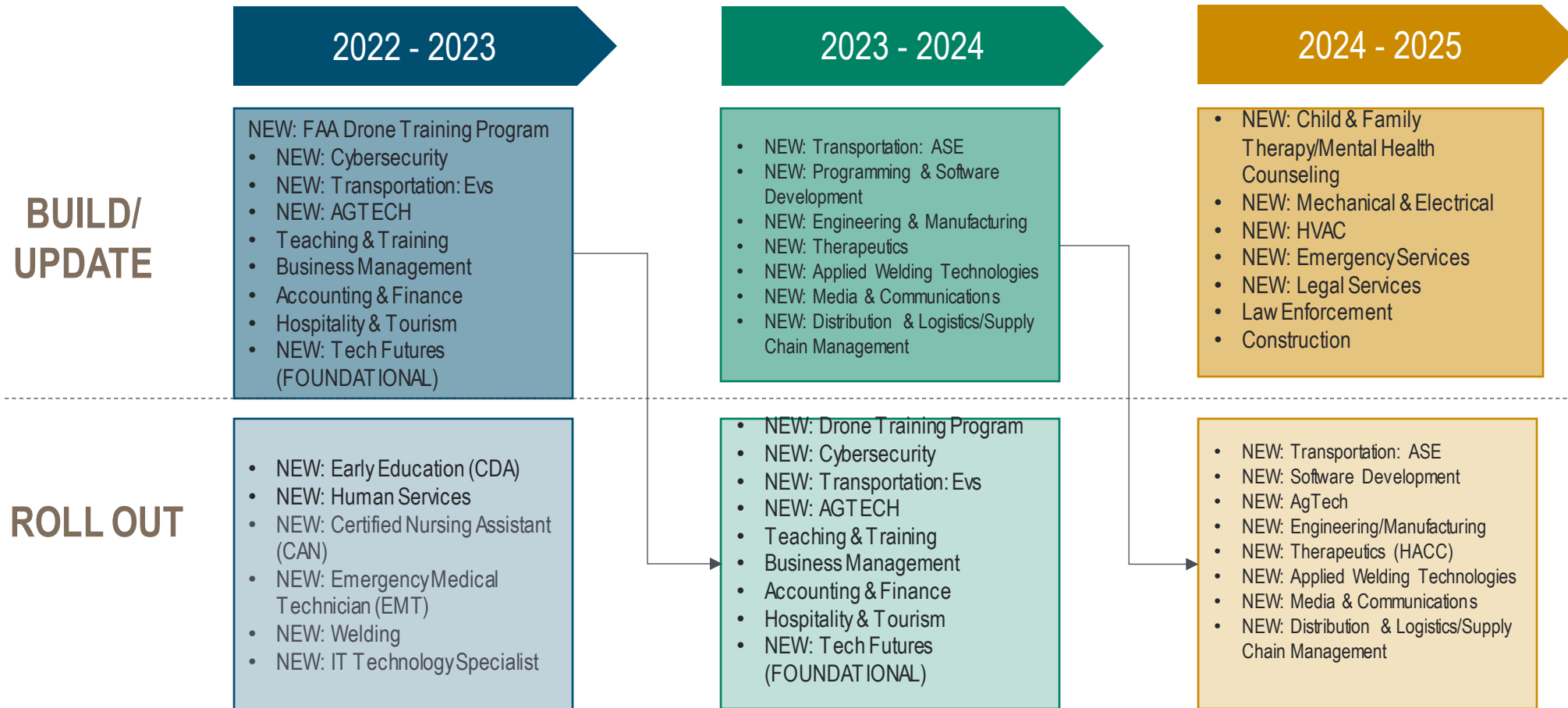


THE FUTURE OF MHS CTE:
